**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN PERSONAL
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF COLUMBIA**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the City of Columbia ("City"), it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the City to retain the following described personal property now owned by it:

1980 Winston Mobile Home Trailer, VIN 8746
(Surplus Property)

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and City Council that it is in the best interest of the City to dispose of that Surplus Property in the manner described in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MONROE AND ST. CLAIR COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois.

Section 2: Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois, find that the Surplus Property, now owned by the City of Columbia, is no longer necessary or useful to the City of Columbia, and the best interest of the City of Columbia will be served by its disposal because said Surplus Property has negative value.

Section 3: Pursuant to said Section 11-76-4, the City may sell or dispose of this Surplus Property in the manner most appropriate to the City. The Surplus Property must be sold or disposed of in "as is" condition.

Section 4: The City Administrator is authorized to dispose of said Surplus Property by transferring it to the Boy Scouts who can strip it down and haul it off for scrap.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.




