

**CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE NO. 3483**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A REPLACEMENT
MEMBER TO THE PARK & RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD**

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia (“City”), Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 3464 on June 3, 2019, thereby appointing members of certain boards, commissions, and committees for the year commencing May 1, 2019 and ending April 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3464 provided for the appointment of nine (9) members to the Columbia PLAY Commission, to serve three (3) year terms; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 3474 on October 7, 2019, which dissolved the Columbia PLAY Commission, established the Park & Recreation Advisory Board, and named the appointees to the former PLAY Commission as the inaugural members of the Park & Recreation Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Gina Segobiano, Superintendent of Columbia CUSD 4, has resigned as the school district’s representative to the Park & Recreation Advisory Board and CUSD 4 has asked Mayor Hutchinson to name Assistant Superintendent Courtney Castelli as her replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to appoint Courtney Castelli to fill Dr. Segobiano’s vacancy on the Park & Recreation Advisory Board and complete said vacated term.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, as follows:

Section 1. The preceding recitations in the upper part of this Ordinance are realleged, restated and adopted as paragraph one (“1”) of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Council hereby accept the resignation of Dr. Gina Segobiano, thanking her for her service to the community, and appoint Courtney Castelli as a member of the Park & Recreation Advisory Board. Such term is to begin immediately and shall expire on April 30, 2022.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Corporate Authorities.

PASSED by the City Council and **APPROVED** by the Mayor of the City of Columbia, Illinois and deposited and filed in the office of the City Clerk on the 2nd day of December, 2019, the vote being taken by ayes and noes and entered upon the legislative record as follows:
