Mr. Hoeffken then stated he would like to appoint Kelly Mathews as his Deputy Clerk effective February 1, 2019. Mr. Morani then explained the hourly rate for Mrs. Mathews would be increased to \$16.50. He also explained other changes to the Salary Ordinance, including removing individual names from the ordinance and listing pay ranges as a way to minimize potential issues among staff as well as keep flexibility when moving personnel to different positions. Mr. Morani added the ordinance will also amend other recent staff changes, including the appointment of Linda Sharp as Acting City Treasurer.

III. Adjournment


Mayor Hutchinson asked for a motion to adjourn the Executive Session.
