**ORDINANCE NO. 2964**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN MONROE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AND THE  
CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS WITH REGARD TO THE  
VALMEYER ROAD BRIDGE REHABILITATION  
(SECTION 12-00023-01-BR) IN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA,  
ILLINOIS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City") desires to improve the Valmeyer Road Bridge over Carr Creek as the superstructure is becoming structurally deficient; and

WHEREAS, Monroe County, Illinois (the "County") has available funding that can be utilized toward the local share of the cost of construction per Illinois State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County have found and determined and do hereby declare it is necessary and appropriate and in the interest of improved transportation facilities and safety to the motoring public that the City and the County make and enter into an Agreement between the City and the County for the funding of said Valmeyer Road Bridge Rehabilitation (Section 12-00023-01-BR); and

WHEREAS, the City does hereby enact this Ordinance for the purpose of authorizing said Agreement for the Valmeyer Road Bridge Rehabilitation (Section 12-00023-01-BR), to approve the form and content thereof and to authorize the Mayor to make and enter into said Agreement for and on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

**Section 2.** The City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois does hereby and herewith authorize the Mayor to make and enter into the "Agreement for the Valmeyer Road Bridge Rehabilitation (Section 12-00023-01-BR) between the City of Columbia, Illinois, and Monroe County, Illinois", which is hereby approved as to form; and, said City Council does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute the same for and on behalf of the City, in as many counterparts as the Mayor shall determine.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, as provided by law.

Alderman Ebersohl moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Reis, and the roll call vote was as follows:

ABSENT: Alderman Mathews.




Attached is a DRAFT Agreement between the City of Columbia and County of Monroe for the above referenced project for your review. Please make any recommended revisions and return to me for correction.

My only concern at this time, is the existing structure is on a 45° skew, IDOT frowns on the use of PPC deck beams at a skew of greater than 30°, this will need to be addressed during plan preparation.

AGREEMENT

VALMEYER ROAD BRIDGE REHABILITATION – SECTION 12-00023-01-BR

BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA AND THE COUNTY OF MONROE

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2012, by and between the County of Monroe (County) and the City of Columbia (City):

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement, in the interest of improved transportation facilities and safety to the motoring public wish to cooperate in the improvement of Valmeyer Road Bridge (FAU 9304) within the City at its crossing of Carr Creek; and

WHEREAS, said improvement will be of immediate benefit to the residents of the City of Columbia and rural Monroe County, and permanent in nature!

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The City agrees to prepare or cause to be prepared plans and specifications, furnish engineering during construction, and cause the improvement to be built in accordance with the plans, specifications and construction contract approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
2. The City agrees to prepare or cause to be prepared the plats, deeds, and appraisals, and perform all negotiations necessary to acquire all needed additional right-of-way (this includes acquisition by eminent domain, if necessary). The City is responsible for all payments for right-of-way acquisition.
3. The County and City agree to cause utilities located within the project to be relocated or adjusted, if necessary.
4. The County and City agree that the plans for this improvement will be prepared in accordance with the rules and guidelines of the State of Illinois for federal participation and that the actual contract for the bridge work will be let and executed by the State of Illinois Department of Transportation.
5. The City and County will share in the project costs on the following percentage (%) basis with the actual amount dependent on the final cost of construction and engineering.

The amounts shown shall be allowed to increase up to 25% based on actual costs at time of construction. Any expenditure for line items in excess of the 25% amount will require prior approval of the County and City before work on that item can be authorized to proceed.

6. Utility relocations are not anticipated. However, in the event they are, the City will relocate city owned utilities as needed to allow for construction. Any non-municipal utilities relocation costs will be split 50/50 between City and County.
7. Work to be performed shall include: removal of existing superstructure, new 17" precast prestressed deck beams, waterproofing membrane, hot mix asphalt overlay, steel bridge rail, terminal end sections and miscellaneous approach work. See attached Exhibit "A" Location Map and Exhibit "B" Estimate of Costs.
8. The City will be the contracting agency for all work provided for by this agreement and will invoice the County for its participating share as payments are due.
9. Upon completion of the improvement maintenance/jurisdiction of the street will remain the responsibility of the City.
10. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors, and assigns.


“A” – LOCATION MAP
