II. STATED PURPOSE

Mayor Hutchinson stated the Executive Session was called to Update/Discuss Collective Bargaining/Employee Wages.

A. Collective Bargaining/Employee Wages Discussion

City Administrator Al Hudzik began the Executive session with a review of the current medical/prescription and drug premiums and projections of what future costs may be for the Steelworkers Health and Welfare Fund Insurance. Mr. Hudzik updated the Council and the Mayor on an August 15th meeting held with Mark Russillo, a representative of the Officers/Telecommunicators' Unit for the purpose of discussing proposals made by the City and the Officers/Telecommunicators regarding salary and the health insurance issues.

City Labor Attorney Mark Weisman, joined by Mr. Hudzik, the Mayor and several aldermen, discussed the current proposals and several possible scenarios regarding future proposals regarding the contract negotiations with the Officers/Telecommunicators and DOPW.

After debate, with all aldermen having the opportunity to comment and offer opinions, it was the consensus of the Council to provide guidelines for year's one, two and three in the negotiation process (for a three year contract) and to instruct Mr. Weisman and Mr. Hudzik to proceed with negotiations within the provided guidelines.

There being no further business to be brought before the Council in Executive Session, Mayor Hutchinson asked for a motion to return to the Regular Session of the City Council at 8:38 P.M.


