**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 34-5-12 OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA
MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING SIDEWALKS**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia (“City Council”) previously adopted Section 34-5-12 of the City of Columbia Municipal Code (“City Code”), addressing sidewalks within the City of Columbia (“City”); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is in the best interest of the City, and now desires to amend Section 34-5-12 of the City Code.

Section 34-5-12 SIDEWALKS. Sidewalks shall be of Portland Cement concrete, with a minimum thickness of four (4) inches and a minimum width of four (4) feet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the preceding recitations in the upper part of this Ordinance are realleged, restated and adopted as paragraph one (“1”) of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That Section 34-5-12 of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 34-5-12 SIDEWALKS. Sidewalks shall be constructed with a minimum thickness of four (4) inches of Portland Cement concrete and a base of two (2) inches of clean aggregate base.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as provided by law.


