

ORDINANCE NO. 2498

AN ORDINANCE TO FILL THE OFFICE OF CITY ENGINEER AND SET THE COMPENSATION OF THAT APPOINTED CITY OFFICER FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE CITY WHICH COMMENCED MAY 1, 2006 AND WILL END APRIL 30, 2007

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2497 of the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City"), enacted even date herewith and prior hereto, the office of City Engineer was created;

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2460, enacted May 1, 2006, said Ordinance did fill offices and set compensation of appointed City Officers for the fiscal year of the City commencing May 1, 2006 and ending April 30, 2007;

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that Section 3 thereof, entitled "Professional Appointed City Officers" be amended to add thereto the office of "City Engineer" and to fill the office and set the compensation of said appointed City officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

Section 2. City Ordinance No. 2460, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE TO FILL THE OFFICE AND SET THE COMPENSATION OF APPOINTED CITY OFFICERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE CITY COMMENCING MAY 1, 2006 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2007"

Section 2, entitled: "Professional City Officers" is hereby changed and amended to add thereto Subsection (C) to be entitled "City Engineer", and to read as follows:

"Section 3. Professional Appointed City Officers.

The following persons or firms are appointed to fill the following appointed City offices for the one (1) year term commencing May 1, 2006 and ending April 30, 2007, for the following salary or compensation, to wit:

- (A) City Attorney
- (B) City Auditor

(C) City Engineer. Ronald J. Williams, P. E., who currently resides at 1115 East First Street, Washington, Missouri 63090, is appointed as City Engineer for the remainder of the ensuing fiscal year for the following compensation:

(1) Annual Salary - \$88,000. This salary shall be subject to annual adjustment as determined and set forth in the City's annually enacted salary ordinance.

(2) Moving Bonus. A \$5,000 one-time moving bonus shall be given to Ronald J. Williams if he moves within the corporate limits of the City of Columbia, Illinois by Monday, November 3, 2008.

(3) Service Benefits. The City Engineer/Director of Public Works shall receive all benefits that apply to the City's Personnel Code, except for the following items a and b:

a. Compensatory Leave Time. The City Engineer shall receive Compensatory leave time from work, not to exceed forty (40) hours in any fiscal year of the City for time expended in attending evening meetings.

b. Monthly Car Allowance. The City Engineer shall receive a \$250.00 per month car allowance in lieu of any other mileage allowance.

Section 3. Ronald J. Williams is appointed as the Director of Public Works to serve without compensation in addition to the compensation he receives as City Engineer.

Section 4. All ordinance or resolutions, or parts of ordinance or resolutions, in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed, including Ordinance No. 829 enacted April 30, 1990 abolishing the office of City Engineer.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, as provided by law.

Alderman Niemietz moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Koesterer, and the roll call vote was as follows:




