AN ORDINANCE DELETING CHAPTER 2.30, SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF TITLE 2, ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Public Works is currently an appointed city official even though the position reports directly to the appointed position of Director of Public Works/City Engineer.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to make the Superintendent of Public Works an exempt, at-will employee.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois has determined that it is necessary and appropriate and in the public interest to delete Chapter 2.30, Superintendent of Public Works of Title 2, Administration and Personnel, of the Municipal Code of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

Section 2. Chapter 2.30, Superintendent of Public Works of Title 2, Administration and Personnel of the Municipal Code of the City is hereby deleted.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.


