
II. PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Hutchinson stated the Public Hearing was called to hear comments from the public at large regarding the City making and entering into a Real Estate Exchange Agreement with Budnick Converting, Inc., a Delaware Corporation authorized to do business in the State of Illinois with regard to the exchange of real estate to the Mark L. Wegmann Trust and to Harold and Dorothy Schmidt for real estate belonging to Budnick Converting, Inc. Mr. Adams summarized the history resulting in the reason for the property exchange.
